

ANNOUNCEMENT

It was reported in today's edition (21 January 2008) of The Business Times that the Singapore Sports Hub Consortium (the "**Consortium**"), which has been picked as the preferred bidder for the Sports Hub, is in preliminary talks with Genting International P.L.C. (the "**Company**") to build a hotel in the Sports Hub.

The Board of Directors of the Company is pleased to confirm that it is in discussions with the Consortium in relation to the building of a hotel in the Sports Hub. Various details are still being worked out between the Company and the Consortium.

The Company is delighted to have this opportunity to support both the Government's efforts in promoting the leisure sector in Singapore and participating in the future success of the Sports Hub.

Preliminary planning suggests the future hotel could have over 500 rooms which would significantly add to the managed room stock of the Company's integrated resort on Sentosa when it is operational.

The subject-matter of this announcement is not expected to have any material impact on the consolidated net tangible assets and earnings per share of the Company for the financial year ending 31 December 2008.
