

ANNOUNCEMENT

RECEIPT OF ONLINE GAMING LICENCE BY GENTING STANLEY ALDERNEY LIMITED

On 3 January 2008, Genting International P.L.C. (the “**Company**”) announced that the Company had received approval from the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the “**SGX-ST**”) for the conduct of gaming operations (including online gaming) in Alderney (British Channel Islands) and/or the United Kingdom and that the Company intends to apply to the Alderney Gambling Control Commission (“**AGCC**”) for an online gaming licence through its wholly owned subsidiary Genting Stanley Alderney Limited (“**GSAL**”).

The Board of Directors of the Company is pleased to announce that GSAL has received the online gaming licence from AGCC. The permission to go live is still subject to AGCC’s approval of the Internal Control System and the Gambling Equipment. GSAL anticipates that its online gaming business would commence during the later part of the second quarter of 2008. Further details will be made available in due course.

Financial Effects

The receipt of the online gaming licence and the anticipated commencement of the online gaming business are not expected to have any material impact on the consolidated net tangible assets and earnings per share of the Company for the financial year ending 31 December 2008.

Directors’ and Substantial Shareholders’ Interest

None of the Directors or substantial shareholders of the Company has any interest, direct or indirect in the receipt of the online gaming licence by GSAL.
