Second quarter performance review

For the second quarter of 2010, the Group recorded revenue of S\$979.3 million, compared to S\$120.1 million in the second quarter of 2009. The Group earnings before interest, tax, depreciation and amortisation ("EBITDA") was S\$513.9 million with EBITDA margin of 52% in the

second quarter of 2010 compared to an EBITDA of S\$4.0 million with EBITDA margin of 3% in the second quarter of 2009.

After the commencement of operations of Resorts World Sentosa ("RWS"), Singapore's first Integrated Resort ("Singapore IR") in the first quarter of 2010, all major business segments within the Singapore IR continued to grow and strengthen. Singapore IR provides visitors with an array of wonderful memorable experiences and behind the scenes, the operational resources devoted to ensure the complete experience is comprehensive and requires quality management and tight integration of the various business units. We continue to make significant progress in all these areas. Our sales and marketing efforts gained more traction in our primary geographical and segmental markets as we executed our strategies.

Singapore IR recorded revenue of S\$860.8 million and EBITDA of S\$503.5 million for the second quarter of 2010 with EBITDA margin standing at 58% at the back of higher than industry average win percentage in the premium players market. Universal Studio Singapore ("USS") increased its daily maximum capacity to about 8,000 with an average visitor spend of S\$84. RWS hotels' occupancy was 70% with an average room rate of S\$263.

UK casino operations' revenue for the second quarter of 2010 was S\$104.9 million, decreased by 3% compared to S\$108.0 million in second quarter of 2009, mainly affected by currency translation of the weak Sterling Pound against the Singapore Dollar. The underlying revenue of UK casino operations in Sterling Pound has improved by 6% contributed by higher business volume. EBITDA decreased by 25% to S\$9.1 million in the second quarter of 2010 as a result of bad debt written off.

Group profit after tax in the second quarter of 2010 was S\$396.5 million, compared to a loss of S\$50.7 million in the second quarter of 2009 attributed mainly to the strong result generated from Singapore IR.

### First half year performance review

For the first half year of 2010, the Group revenue increased to S\$1,439.7 million compared to revenue in the first half year of 2009 of S\$225.5 million. The increase is mainly from the commencement of operations of Singapore IR which contributed 83% of the Group revenue.

The Group recorded a net profit of S\$0.2 million mainly attributable to the following:

- a) Singapore IR contributed an EBITDA of S\$612.4 million compared to a net loss of S\$23.7 million in the first half year of 2009 due to the commencement of business of four hotels, restaurants, the casino and USS during the first quarter of 2010;
- b) UK casino operations contributed EBITDA of S\$25.8 million compared to S\$20.5 million in the first half year of 2009 mainly due to improved luck factor; and
- c) Fair value gain on derivative financial instruments of S\$28.4 million arising mainly from the valuation of the conversion option embedded in the Group's convertible bonds as compared to a fair value loss of S\$16.6 million recognised in the first half year of 2009.

The above has been reduced by:

- a) Impairment loss on intangible assets of S\$478.1 million net off against the reversal of deferred tax liability to taxation of S\$86.4 million relating to the UK casino operations mainly due to the unfavourable economic climate in the UK which is expected to adversely impact the Group's UK business;

- b) Depreciation and amortisation increased by S\$92.6 million to S\$110.0 million mainly due to the commencement of operations of Singapore IR; and
- c) Higher finance costs on borrowings of S\$65.9 million in the first half of 2010 compared to S\$29.2 million recorded in the first half year of 2009. The higher finance costs was mainly due to interest on borrowings for the Singapore IR charged to profit and loss account after commencement of operations offset by decrease in interest on convertible bonds which were fully converted as of February 2010.

During the six month period, Resorts World at Sentosa Pte Ltd (“RWSPL”) drew down the remaining S\$900 million from its syndicated loan facility to finance its construction and development of the integrated resort bringing total drawdown to S\$4.0 billion as at 30 June 2010. RWSPL spent a total of S\$826 million for construction work-in-progress and other property, plant and equipment during the financial period.

The Group also recognised an impairment loss on intangible assets of S\$478.1 million and reversal of deferred tax liability to taxation of S\$86.4 million in the first six month period ended 30 June 2010 relating to UK casino operations, giving a net impact of S\$391.7 million.

Other than the above and as disclosed in the other notes, there have been no material factors that affected the cash flow, working capital, assets or liabilities of the Group.

**Singapore**

2010 is a major milestone in the corporate life of the Group, beginning with RWSPL meeting its aggressive timeline to open the resort in the first quarter of 2010 and then with most of its operations commencing in the same quarter. We created history by opening Singapore’s first Integrated Resort at a record time of 34 months after groundbreaking in April 2007.

Resorts World Sentosa’s phased opening began on 20 January with its four hotels - Festive Hotel, Hard Rock Hotel Singapore, Hotel Michael and Crockfords Tower. On 6 February 2010, RWSPL was issued a casino licence by the Casino Regulatory Authority of Singapore. The casino commenced business on 14 February 2010, the first day of Chinese New Year. This was followed a month later with the opening of Universal Studios Singapore on 18 March 2010. With the opening of Marina Bay Sands, our business showed resilience and our business model displayed impressive strength. We continue to be optimistic with our business model for the rest of the year.

The resort hosted a series of high-profile entertainment events and promotions, and will continue to fill the rest of its year-long calendar with activities to encourage fresh and repeat visitations. The RWS destination resort has garnered good visibility in our primary markets. Our marketing and public relations efforts have made considerable impact in deriving record visitor numbers to RWS and Singapore. We continue to make improvements to our attractions, facilities and infrastructure to meet the expectations of our valued guests. Staff training on service delivery continues, as the resort works towards a distinction for customer service excellence.

RWSPL has also commenced construction of the West Zone, which comprises the Maritime Xperiential Museum - featuring one of the world's largest aquaria, the Marine Life Park, a destination spa and luxurious accommodation at its Equarius Hotel and Spa Villas. The West Zone is expected to commence operations progressively from year 2011.

**Proposed divestment of the United Kingdom ("UK") casino operations**

The Board of Directors of the Company has on 1 July 2010 announced that it has entered into a conditional sale and purchase agreement in connection with the sale to Genting Worldwide (UK) Limited ("GWUK"), an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of Genting Malaysia Berhad ("GENM"), of the Group's UK casino operations at a consideration of £340 million, which may be adjusted in accordance with the adjustment mechanism. The consideration was arrived at after arm's length negotiations and on a willing-buyer and willing-seller basis. The proposed divestment is conditional on, amongst others, the approval of the Company's and GENM's shareholders. The Company's Extraordinary General Meeting will be held on 18 August 2010.
